Here's what's on and how you can get involved at St Andrew's:

Food Hub and Community Cafe

Every Wednesday between 2pm and 4pm we give away free food to those who need it, and hot drinks and cakes/biscuits to everyone. No referrals needed – just pop in. We have a large team of volunteers who collect surplus food or serve it out – if you're interested in volunteering, come along on a Wednesday and introduce yourself.

Youth Café

Also on Wednesdays, term time only from 3.30-5pm. Open to all 11-16 year olds. Drop into the Church Centre for free snacks, games, chat, and a warm safe space to socialise.

Contemplative Communion & Coffee Hour

Finally, also on Wednesdays, why not join us for our popular 'Contemplative Communion' service at 10am and/or our 'Coffee Hour from 11am-12pm.

Chirpy Cherries

On a Friday (in term time) 9.30-11am we have Chirpy Cherries, our singing based baby/toddler group meeting in our Church Centre. Do drop in to this fun, free and supportive group for carers and preschool children.

Sunday Church Services

We have such a diverse congregation — so we put on a range of kinds of church.

On the first and third Sundays of each month we have a 9am Book of Common Prayer service – it's short (40mins) and includes communion and sermon but no songs. This is followed by Café Church which begins with refreshments served from 10am; the informal service, around tables, begins at 10.30am and ends at 11.30am. There are activities for all ages, a worship band, and communion. 'The best all age worship I've ever been to' is the usual comment from visitors.

On the second and fourth Sundays of each month we have a more formal Sung Communion service at 10am, with a 'PRayground' (on the second Sunday) for children in the Church Centre, which is all about helping children find their own ways of encountering God. On the fourth Sunday Sung Communion is followed by Forest Church outside and Brunch Church for youth in the Church Centre,


When a month has a fifth Sunday, why not join us for a special Songs of Praise service at 10am. We also have special services to celebrate Christian festivals and a shorter Summer Church in August, always at 10am.

Basic rule of thumb is that if you show up for 10am on a Sunday, you'll find something going on at St Andrew's.

And if this sounds too busy or confusing – on the 3rd and 4th Sunday of each month, you can join our Silent Prayer & Meditation service at 4pm.

We're always very happy to chat through the different options with you and try to find something that will suit you – and to encourage you to try other styles of worship too...

We rely on volunteers to put on all our services and community programs – and we can find a role for you! There are so many ways to get involved, from joining the Churchyard band of gardeners, to joining the band of bell ringers – from working the sound desk, to working with young people. Do come and find out how you can be part of this thriving, creative church community!
